OFFICE ORDER NO. 138 /2018-PPC

With reference to the Office Order No. 335/2016 dated 22.11.2016 and No. 218/2017-PPC dated 06.10.2017 regarding implementation of Medical Policy for PB employees recruited after 05.10.2007 and in pursuance of the implementation of the 7th CPC recommendations, in respect of such employees, the following is clarified with regard to the permissible limit of medical re-imbursement for such employees in case of OPD treatment:-

SI.		Maximum medical reimbursement per
No.	after 05.10.2007 as per 7 th CPC	annum for OPD treatment
i.	Upto Rs. 60,000/-	Rs. 30,000/-
ii	More than Rs. 60,000/-	50% of Basic pay subject to maximum
		reimbursement of Rs. 75,000/-

- 2. The reimbursement towards OPD treatment would not be restricted as per CGHS Rates and would be as per actuals (subject to limit indicated above) on production of original bills and prescription by Doctor. All other provisions shall continue to be applicable as indicated in the medical policy issued vide Office Order No. 335/2016 dated 22.11.2016 and No. 218/2017-PPC dated 06.10.2017.
- 3. This clarification will have effect from the date of issue of this order.
